Soficopharm has a legal responsibility to monitor the safety of the Products that we have in distribution in Egypt.

Such monitoring of adverse events is called Pharmacovigilance ("PV"). PV requirements exist to allow us and competent regulatory authorities (such as the Egyptian Drug Authority and other suppliers) to manage adverse events and to protect public health and ensure high standards of quality and the safety of Soficopharm Products.

At soficopharm, we are committed to protecting the personal data of our patients, customers, and stakeholders in accordance with the Egyptian Personal Data Protection Law and other relevant regulations

This privacy policy applies to all personal data collected and processed by soficopharm in the course of its pharmaceutical distribution activities, including but not limited to patient information, customer data, and employee records

We adhere to the data protection principles as Accuracy that We ensure the accuracy and up-to-date nature of personal data, Confidentiality and Integrity that We protect personal data against unauthorized access, alteration, or destruction.

We implement security measure to protect personal data access Controls to be Restricted to authorized personnel

We may share personal data with:

- Third-Party Service Providers*: Authorized service providers, subject to contractual agreements ensuring data protection.
- Regulatory Authorities*: Egyptian regulatory authorities, such as the Egyptian drug authority.

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
